



SAHPS - The New Health Planning app for Beef Farmers



- The SAHPS app enables farmers to collect and record data as events occur and allows them to share the data with their vet immediately.
- The SAHPS app is linked to the existing SAHPS (Animal Health Planning) and BCMS (British Cattle Movement System) software.
- Internet is not required to record events however all data can be uploaded to SAHPS and BCMS when Wi-Fi and/or mobile phone data become available.

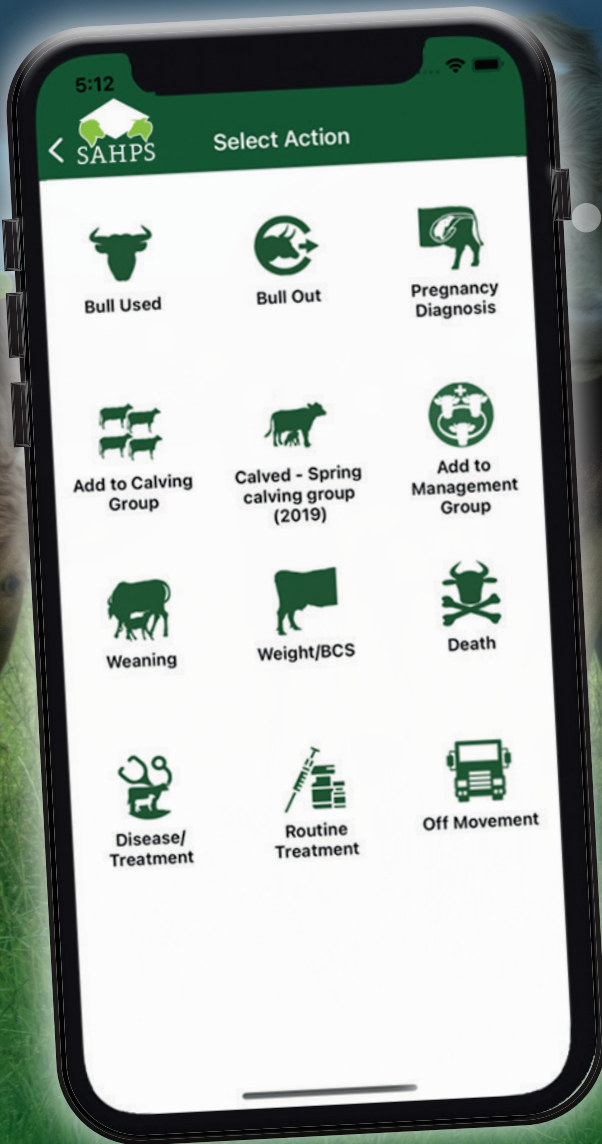
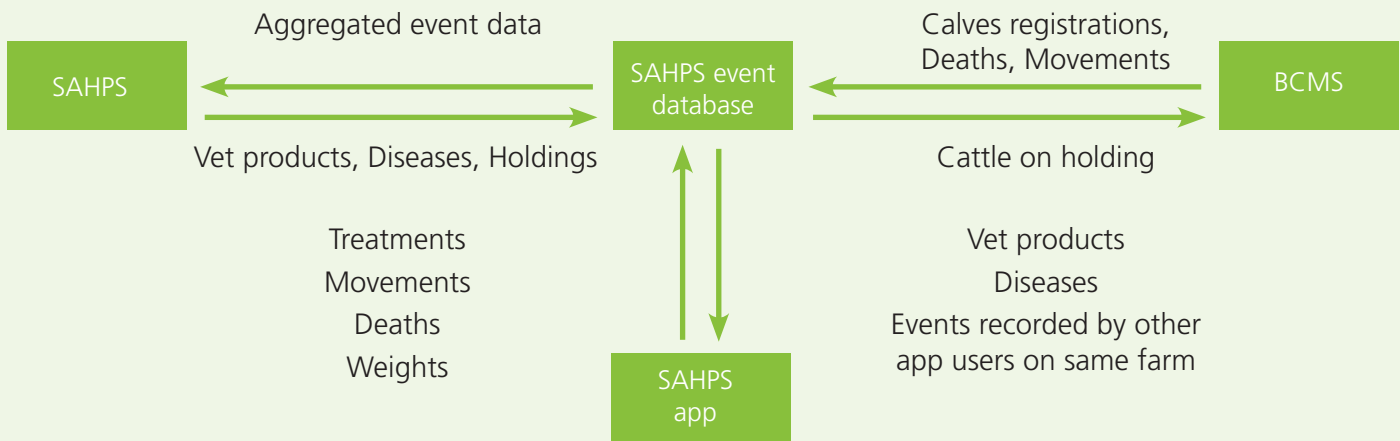


Key features:

- Record weaning information
